#### Classes

- 1. In hand
- 2. Easy (approximately 10 obstacles)
- 3. Intermediate (approximately 15 obstacles)
- 4. Advanced (approximately 20 obstacles,)
- All combinations may enter any combination of or all classes except for led/assisted riders- not eligible for Class 4
- Judged under ease of handling and novelty rules.

- Classes may be split or combined by age, depending on entries.
- Riders to compete in full or mounted games competition uniform.
- Horse and Rider Combinations to be qualified financial members. Combinations in Class 4 will need a graded performance card.
- Members holding a non-riding membership may enter Class One, but must wear PCA approved helmet and boots & provide proof of membership.
- Led or Assisted riders must remain so throughout the day and are not eligible for Class 4
